Tie Dye T-Shirts

1 packet of koolaid, 1/4 cup vinegar, 2 cups water, t-shirt

Stir ingredients together in a pot. Bring solution to a boil and remove from heat.

Wrap parts of a t-shirt tightly with rubberbands. Put on gloves (koolaid stains hands). Put as many colors in buckets as you want and then place the shirt (or parts of the shirt) into the colorful dye. Once they are dry, they are ready to be worn!

What did we do this week? (kids, describe these fun things to your parents—parents, talk with your kids about their activities)

- We did several experiments like blowing up a balloon without air, we used a chemical reaction to make a gas—we saw how different objects weighing different amounts could sit on top of each other and not mix up
- We made ooze, poppers, silly putty, a volcano, glitter bottles, and chia heads
