Make a Tunic for wearing at home  
Get a pillowcase (the ones from goodwill are the great and very inexpensive). Cut out arm and neck holes. Decorate the front with medieval clipart—a dragon, a castle, a crown, a shield, a sword, anything you can dream up! Add a belt and voila! Instant medieval tunic for being a knight or a lady at home.

Making a sword/shield to use at home. Foam core board (can get it sometimes at walmart look where the items are for science fair projects). Draw the shape of a sword on it, cut it out, and you're ready to show off your medieval swordsmanship

What did we do this week? (kids, describe these fun things to your parents—parents, talk with your kids about their activities)

- We picked out our medieval names (remember Miss Bobbie is Saoria)
- We made several items to wear: tunic, belt pouch, crown, stained glass candle
- We made our own coat of arms
- We played medieval games such as capture the flag (as a team just like a medieval village), pente, alquerque (mancala) and others
- We decorated mazes, coloring pages, and dot to dots
- We learned about many things like sword etiquette, the ways of children in medieval times, and we imagined how it might have been without indoor plumbing, electricity, air conditioning, and lights
